## **Full-Time Position**

40 hours per week; Pay starts at \$17/hour, with the opportunity to increase to \$18.44/hour after a 90-day probationary period

### **Qualifications:**

- High school diploma or equivalent is required
- Experience working with trauma survivors preferred
- Excellent computer skills including knowledge of Microsoft Office required
- Knowledge of domestic violence, sexual assault and human trafficking preferred
- Extreme tact and discretion required
- Experience in crisis intervention preferred
- Knowledge of child development, psychology & education required
- Bilingual applicants are encouraged to apply

### **Duties and responsibilities include but are not limited to:**

- Interacts sensitively with traumatized populations
- Provides direct services to victims and survivors of abuse (youth and non-offending parent) in La Crosse and Trempealeau Counties
- Facilitates youth support groups
- Ensures shelter school-aged youth are enrolled in school within 72 hours of entry into shelter per McKinney Vento Act
- Collaborates with community groups and service providers
- Provides cross-departmental and or cross-functional support and direct services as assigned and/or requested
